



DEFENCE SECTOR VISIT TO FINLAND & ESTONIA 6-9 MAY 2019

Want to know more about the procurement opportunities in Finland and Estonia and meet the right people within the defence sector? Come and pitch your solutions to the Finnish and Estonian defence authorities and potential partners in the defence sector!

This visit provides an excellent opportunity to meet with leading companies from different areas within the defence sector and procurement specialists within defence. The four-day programme will include seminars, pre-scheduled B2B meetings, networking receptions, and field trips. One of the main themes of the visit is cyber security but the visit is relevant to anyone interested in doing business with the Finnish and Estonian Defence Forces and other companies within the sector. DALO will send staff to support the Danish firms during the whole visit. The Defence Attaché covering the Baltics will also participate.
