How to use trade agreements and save customs expenses

customs duties by using EU's many free trade agreements?

How to use EU's trade agreements and GSP (Generalised Scheme of Preferences)

- Which countries does the EU have trade agreements with?
- How much can be saved in customs duties by using the agreements?
- What are the requirements to get the lower preference duties?
- Which documents are needed?

How to use other countries bilateral trade agreements

 If Danish companies have established production in countries outside the EU, they can use the bilateral trade agreements of the country, where the production takes place. We can provide answers to the questions as mentioned above.

Other issues when exporting from EU:

- What is the customs duty, VAT and other taxes rate on a specific product in any country in the world?
- How is the customs value calculated?
- Which export documents are required?
- Which sanitary/phytosanitary measures are applied in the export market?
- Which requirements are applied regarding for example labelling of products?
